Lasalocid sodium 15% Anticoccidial
feed additive in Granular Form

NutriCid is an anticoccidial feed additive containing 15% of the active ingredient lasalocid sodium, an ionophore anticoccidial. It is indicated for use for the control of coccidiosis in chickens for fattening, chickens reared for laying, turkeys and minor avian species (pheasants, guinea fowl, quails and partridges other than laying birds). Lasalocid, a divalent polyether ionophore antibiotic, is produced by *Streptomyces lasaliensis* and recommended as a medicinal feed additive for continuous use to control coccidiosis in poultry species. It is a broad spectrum anticoccidial agent approved to protect against *Eimeria* species in broilers and replacement pullets, turkeys, pheasants and quails. The mechanism of action of lasalocid and other ionophores has been extensively investigated and reported. Like other carboxylic polyether ionophores, lasalocid disturbs ionic homeostasis, leading to osmotic lysis of coccidia. Lasalocid is not approved for use in laying birds as it partitions into fat (egg yolks) at high concentrations. For completeness, a section on contamination of eggs is included in this evaluation.

Benefits

Caution

Do not allow horses or other equines access to premises or supplements containing lasalocid, as ingestion may be fatal. The safety of lasalocid in unapproved species has not been established. Feeding undiluted or mixing errors resulting in excessive concentrations of lasalocid could be fatal to cattle and sheep.
